



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 25th of October Anno Dom. 1737. The Above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed Unto William Harvuot in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster. Begining at a Black Oak Thence South 10 Degrees East by Vacant Land 216 perches to a Black Oak. Thence North 80 Degrees East by the Same land 168 perches to a small Hickery. Thence North 10 Degrees West by y^e Land 216 perches to a Black Oak. Thence South 80 Degrees West by y^e Vacant Land 168 perches to y^e place of Begining. Containing Two Hundred and fourteen acres beside y^e Allowance of 6th Cent for Roads.
