In persuance of his Warrant dated 14th March 1815- Situate in the old purchase Washington Township Lycoming County and bouned as above.

Note. the part marked A. is Robert (obl.) claim in Right of his Warrant granted 2nd May 1793 for twenty Acres. Survey'd 30th March 1797 by Henry Donnel.
