



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in York Township in the County of York late part of the County of Lancaster, survey'd the 1st day of April 1747 by Thomas Cookson Esq^r late D^y Surv^r of Lancaster County. in pursuance of a License granted by the Hon^{ble} Thomas Penn Esquire Proprietary &c. to Martin Fry and bearing date the 30th October 1736. & is part of Seventy Thousand Acres Survey'd for the Use of the Hon^{ble} the Proprietaries the 19th & 20th days of June 1722. and called the Mannor of Springetsbury. The Lines examined the 17th of May 1758 and found to contain one hundred and one Acres and the Allowance of Six Acres & Cent for Roads and Highways.
