Containing one hundred & sixteen Acres and twenty eight perches with the usual allowance of six acres & Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> Day of May Anno Domini 1769 in Pursuance of an order of Survey to William Oliver bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1766 & Numbered 244.
