



Situate on the head Waters of Dallaver Run in Turbut Township in the County of Northumberland. Surveyed in the Year 1773 by Charles Lukens then Deputy Surveyor - for Dominick Bradley by Virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 1 day of December 1772. and Resurveyed by me on the 10 day of July 1809 agreeable to the old lines. Containing one hundred and Nine acres and one quarter with the usual Allowance of Six & Cent. The Yellow lines Represents fifteen acres part of a Survey made in the Name of Robert Davison the date I have not.
