In pursuance of two Warrants one granted to William Lloyd dated the second day of December 1762, and the other to ~~Wm~~ Ralph Ashton dated the same day. there was Surveyed on the twenty seventh day of May 1765 a certain Tract of Land Situate on the Frankstown branch of Juniata River in the County of Cumberland a few Miles below Frankstown old Town. containing one thousand and seventy one Acres and a half and the usual allowance of six acres & c. for Roads & ca. The Right whereof is now vested in John Little & Richard Tea. Deputy Surveyor.
