



The above Draught describes a Survey made for James Arbuckle on a Piece of Land containing 32 1/2 acres & allowance of 6% percent. In Pursuance of a Warrant in the Name of Mary Graham (or Brymes) bearing Date the 9th Day of May. 1745, directed to my Father. The Land lays between several Tracts under Maryland Patent, the Bounds whereof were not fully known, & therefore the Survey not perfected till the 27th 11th mo. 1769.
