



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Manchester Township in the County of York (late part of the County of Lancaster) containing five Hundred and Eighty Acres and the Allowance of Six Acres & Cent for Roads and Highways. Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1746 by Thomas Cookson Esq<sup>r</sup> late Deputy Surveyor for Lancaster County for Christian Oyster in pursuance of a License under the Hand of the Honourable Thomas Penn Esq<sup>r</sup> bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1736. The Lines examined & Devided between Elias and George Oyster two of the Sons of Christian Oyster deceased by Order of the Orphans Court at York.
