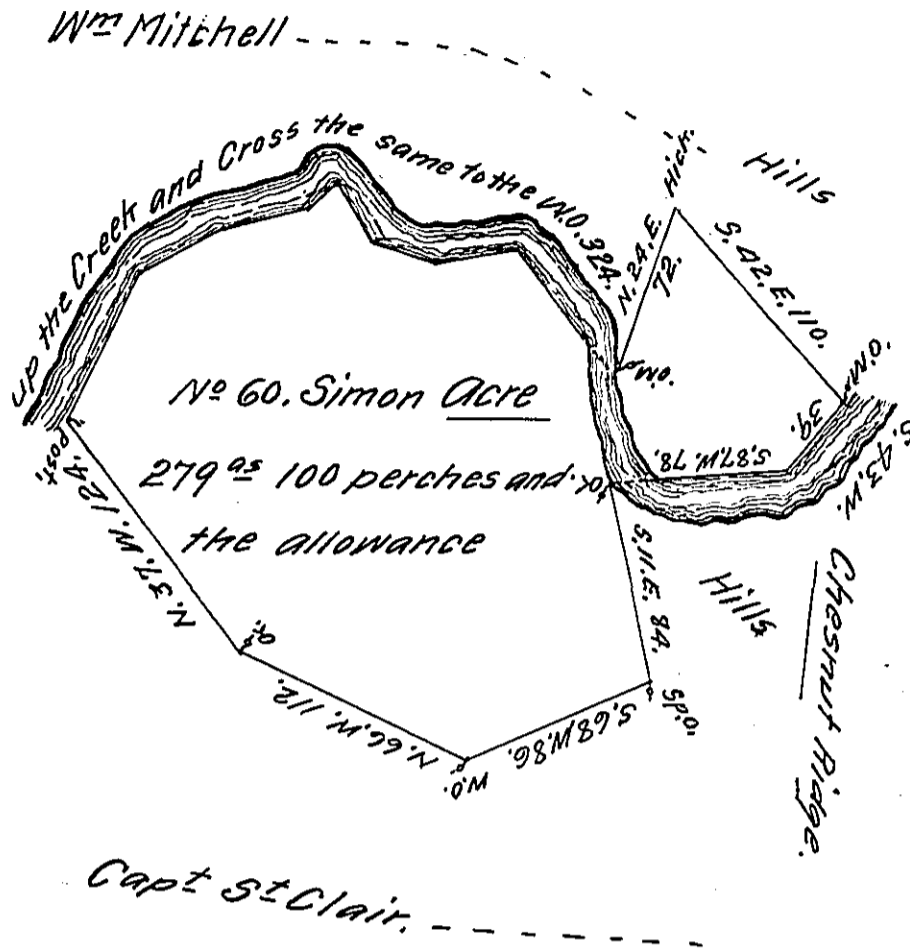

(Called the upright Lott) Surveyed for Simon Eaker October the 17th 1769 In pursuance of an Order No 60 and dated the third of April 1769
