



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being part of a larger Tract of the same Name situate on the most northerly head Branch of the Clearfield Creek about three Miles West of the upper or great Clearfield and 958 Perches Southward of that part of Alexander Stewarts Tract at the Chest where the old Trading Path from Frankstown to the Kittanning crosses the east Line of the said Tract adjoining Land of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Proprietaries, Benjamin Betterton and George Emlin in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and nine Acres and one half Acre and the usual allowance of Six Acres & Cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1773 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Fisher Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the year aforesaid
