 April 1828 for John Kerstetter by Virtue of his Warrant bearing  
 date on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1828 -

N.B. Shortly after the Surry of Kerstetter was made I was inducd to  
 believe that the land had been appropriated & therfor could not return it  
 And not until some time before the issuing of W<sup>m</sup> Boyds warrant  
 that I knew otherwise, when it was found to be fictious or paper Survey.  
 Boyds warrant was for the surplus land included by Kerstetter —  
 Warrant for 5<sup>as</sup> - both surveys has been returnd & a note stating the facts & c  
 W. L.

 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
