By Virtue of an Warrant Dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1751 in the name of David Himple (other wise Colled Himple) by Virtue of the said Warrant there wase Surveyd unto Nicholas Seitzinger and William Miller Certain tract of Lend as it will appeer by the severel Conveyance now Adam Eckman and the said Adam Eckman Sold Part there of unto Jacob Schuler as the above Discribed tract of Lend is Laid Down situated in in the town-ship of Alsace in the County of Berks Containing one Hundred and thirty Six acres and helf and the allowanc\_ of six p cent Survey th\_ 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1774
