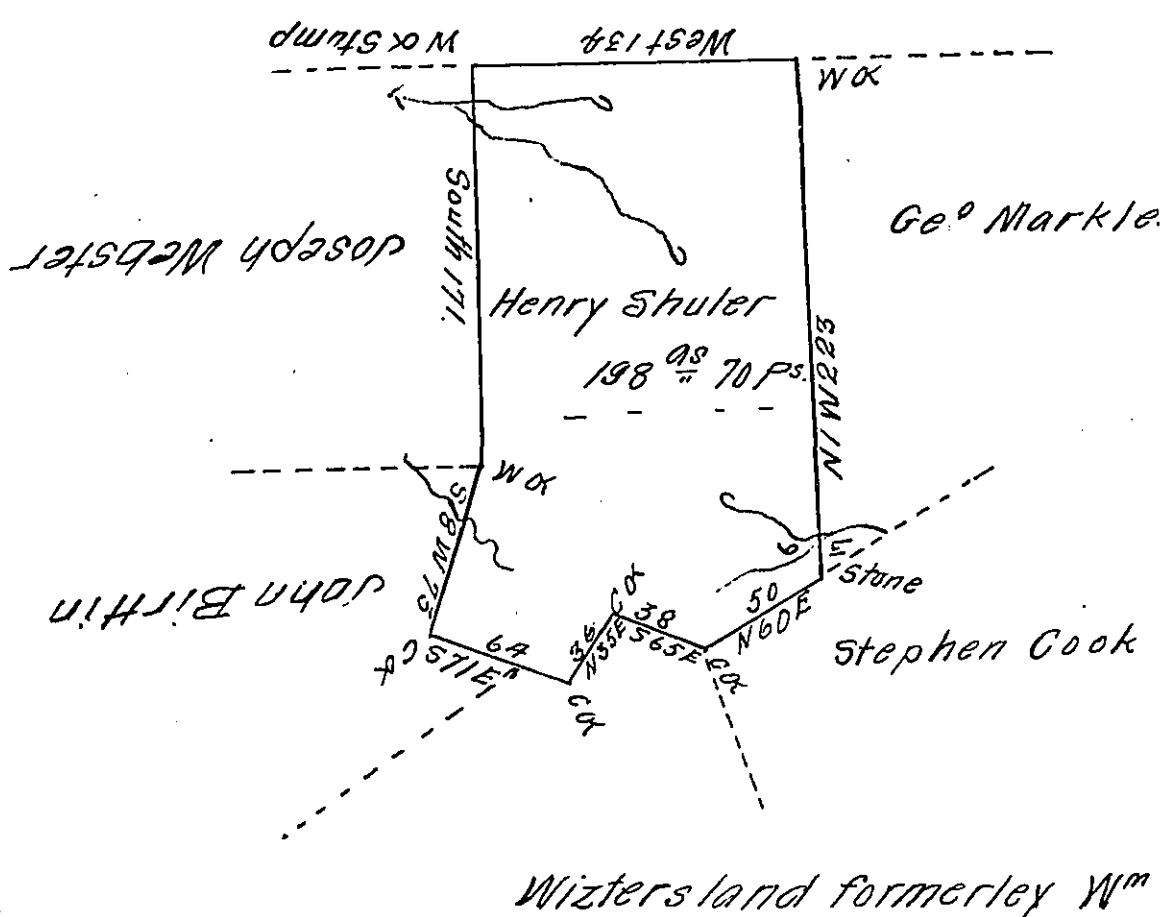

Surveyed the above discribed tract of Land on the first day of December 1826 agreeable to the old line made the 5<sup>th</sup> of July 1787 containing one hundred and ninty eight acres and Seventy perches and allowance of six per obl. for roads & inpersuance of his Warrant in the name of Henry Shuler dated the 17<sup>th</sup> of April 1787 Situated in Muncy Township Lycoming County including two small cablin houses and about ten acres cleared land.
