



A draught of a tract of land situate in Huntington township in the County of York surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> March 1796 by the lines formerly run by Charles Lukens D.S. for the Heirs of John Brandon deceased. In pursuance of a Two warrants one dated the 5<sup>th</sup> February 1754 Granted to George Brandon the other in the name John Brandon Dated the 12 day of July ~~1754~~ <sup>1762</sup> containing Three hundred and five acres and one hundred and Twenty seven perches and allowance of six acres & Cert for roads. &c.
