



In pursuance of two orders one of them numbered 1717 and doted the 28th day of October 1766 and the other numbered 4729 dated the 2^d day of February 1768 I have surveyed on the 24th day of March 1768 for John Wright the above described Tract of Land situate on a branch of Dunnings Creek about six miles northward of Bedford in the County of Cumberland containing Three hundred and sixty four acres and a half and the usual allowance of six acres p.Ct. for Roads & Ga.
