



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in the Township of West Caln, Chester County, Surveyed to Joseph Park Esq. by Virtue of a Warrant in right of James Cummins bearing date 22<sup>nd</sup> of April A.D. 1737. The Courses and Distance is as follows. Viz. Beginning at a Hickory tree on the Division line between Joseph Sharpless and Evan Lewis thence by S. Lewis's land the three following Courses, E. by S. 70 perches to a stone; N. by E. 28 perches to a stone; E. by S. 81 perches to a stone; thence by lands of Samuel Bishop North 46 ps. to a black oak stump; thence West by the lands of Rich<sup>d</sup> Tranter 144 perches & seven tenths of a perch; thence by the lands of the above said Joseph Sharpless; S by W 45 perches to the place of beginning, containing 38 acres  $\frac{3}{4}$  with the usual allowance of six acres per Cent for Roads &c.
