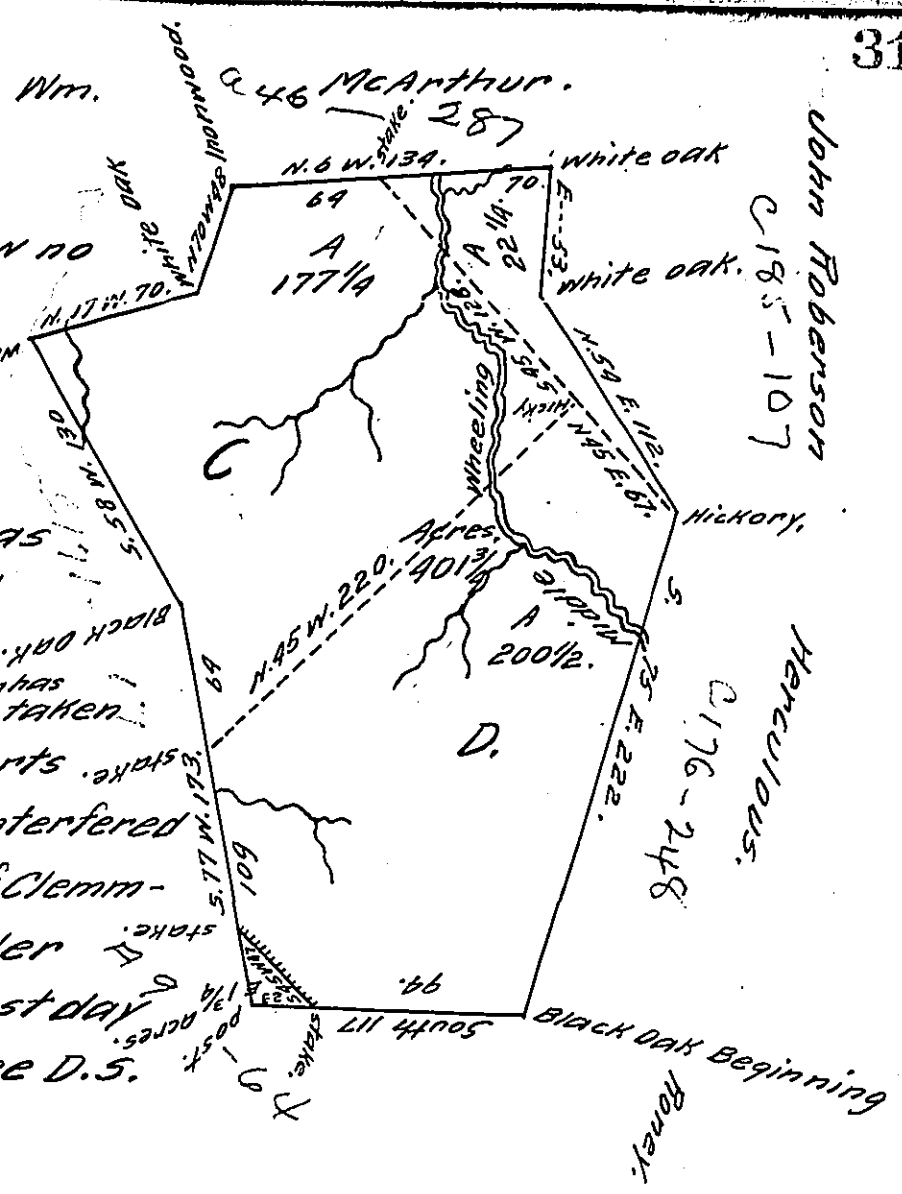

CLK Com's which has been duly entered on Record as will appear by a reference had to the Virginia entries That part of the above described tract of Land circumscribed by dotted lines and marked C containing 177 1/4 acres was surveyed Nov 27th. 1789 on a warrant granted Thomas Fisher October 21 st. 1789 that part of the above Draught circumscribed by dotted lines and marked D containing 200 1/2 Acres. was surveyed Novr. 25th 1789. on a warrant granted to John Bluver on the 21st day of October 1784. and one or more lines obliterated that part divided by a dotted line part of line obliterated containing 1 3/4 as. was surveyed Novr. - th 1789. on a warrant granted George Order, October 21st 1789. It therefore appears that there are but 22 1/4 acres of the above tract clear of dispute
