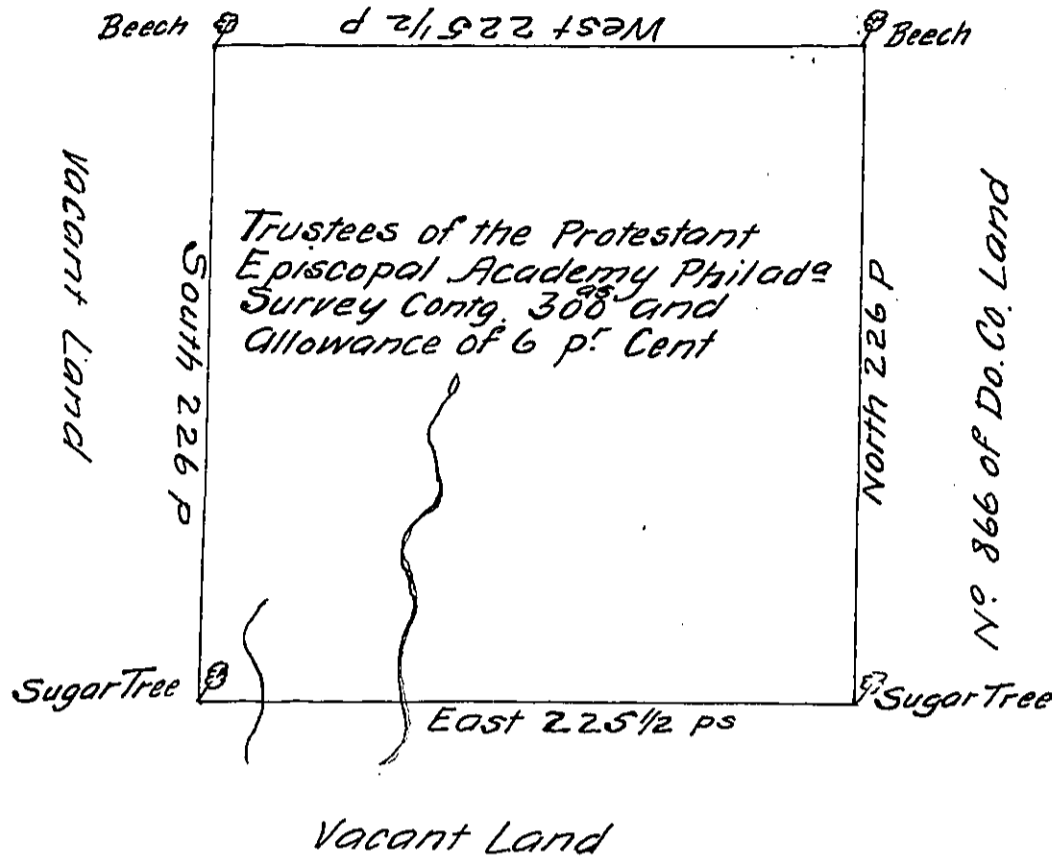


No 854 of Do. Co. Land
