



No. 1 Contains Ninety Seven acres twenty one perches & allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. Originally Surveyed the 8th. day of January, 1763 on a Warrant Granted William Holt dated June the 8th. 1762.

No. 2 Contains One hundred and seventy four Acres 152 pr. & allowance Surveyed December the 10th. 1828 in pursuance of a warrant Granted George Stroop & William McClure for 200 as. Dated March 8th., 1811.
