



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Stock Farms Situate on the Southerly side of the West Branch of Susquehanna on a Run Emptying into the Same about Seven Miles and an half below the Canoe Place adjoining Lands of Samuel Richards & others in the County of Bedford containing three hundred & seven acres & the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 15th Day of November 1775 for Townsend Speakman in Pursuance of a warrant Dated the third Day of August 1773-
