



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Great Cove in this Township in the County of Cumberland Containing Two Hundred and Forty Two Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six Acres for Roads - Surveyed for David Scott on the 11th Day of September 1760, by Virtue of a Warrant bearing Date the Sixth of November 1749 - which Warr^t. does not Locate the Land in the above Draft but being elsewhere Justled out by reason of some prior Warr^t. and finding Scott in peaceable Possession under his private purchase I made the Survey not knowing of any other Pretention at that time, but have since been informed that either a part or the whole of this Tract is Claimed by Abraham Mitchell under a Warr^t. granted to Samuel Budge of the 3^d February 1755. the above is a true State as far as I know to which the Parties themselves will add their private Pretensions.
