



The above is a draft of a tract of Land, situate on the waters of Moon Run in Robinson township Allegheny county, resurveyed for John McC. Fadden on the 28th October 1806, in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property bearing date the 4th March 1806, containing in the whole four hundred and six acres and twenty eight perches and allowance of six percent for roads &c.

Note - that part of the above survey lying South of the dotted line and containing 206 acres & 11 perches was surveyed on the 31st August 1785 in pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres bearing date the 2^d Oct. ~ 1784, granted to George Willis, and that part north of the dotted line, containing 200 acres & 17 perches is what was taken in on the resurvey.
