



A Draught of a Tract of Land called *Pumypack* Situate on the East Side of the North East branch of *Susquehanna River* nearly opposite a place called *Shishiquimung* above and adjoining land surveyed for *Nicholas Tatemy* in the County of *Northumb.* containing two hundred and ninety four acres and three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of 6 pcent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 24th day of September 1773 for *Alexander Anderson* In Pursuance of an Order dated the 13th day of May 1769 No 3222
