



Draft of a tract of unimproved land situated in the township of Hanover in Luzerne County adjoining land of Ezekiel Williams and others containing three hundred ninety nine acres and fourteen perches of land besides the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. The above described tract of land was surveyed forty or fifty years ago for Daniel Vancamp as appears by blocking the line trees upon the ground, and resurveyed on the 7th day of May A.D. 1839 by virtue of his warrant dated the 8th day of January 1793.
