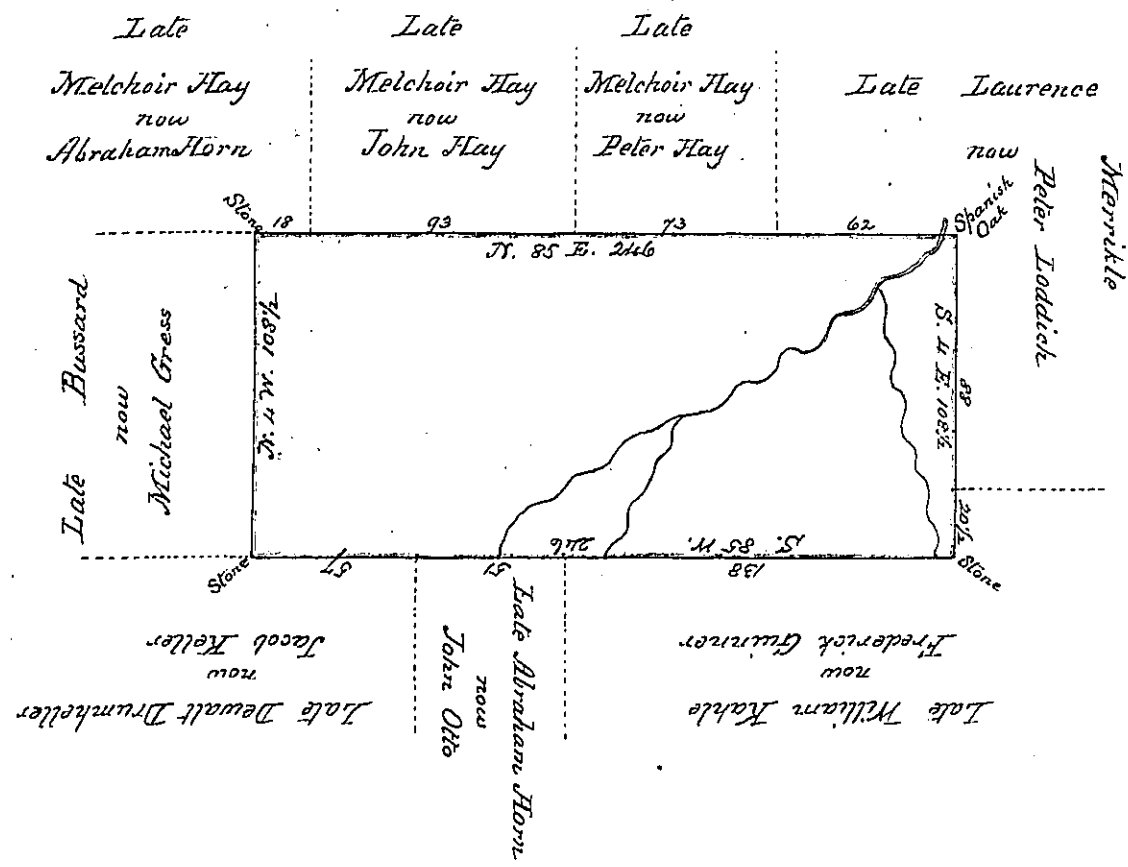


This must be returned on Conrad Hayes' warrant, dated 8th March 1743 40 days of 8.
