



Situate in Pinegrove township Schuylkill county containing seventy five acres and eleven perches and the allowance of six per centum, surveyed on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1825 at the special request of Samuel G. Franks Esquire on a warrant\* granted him for two hundred acres unimproved land situate in Norwauque township in the county aforesaid adjoining land of the New York and Schuylkill Coal Company on the South land surveyed to Michael Kunkel on the north, land to be surveyed to him by a warrant on application made by him this day and on the west to unknown lands, which said warrant could not be located agreeably to its description the land therein described having been appropriated on prior warrants previously located.
