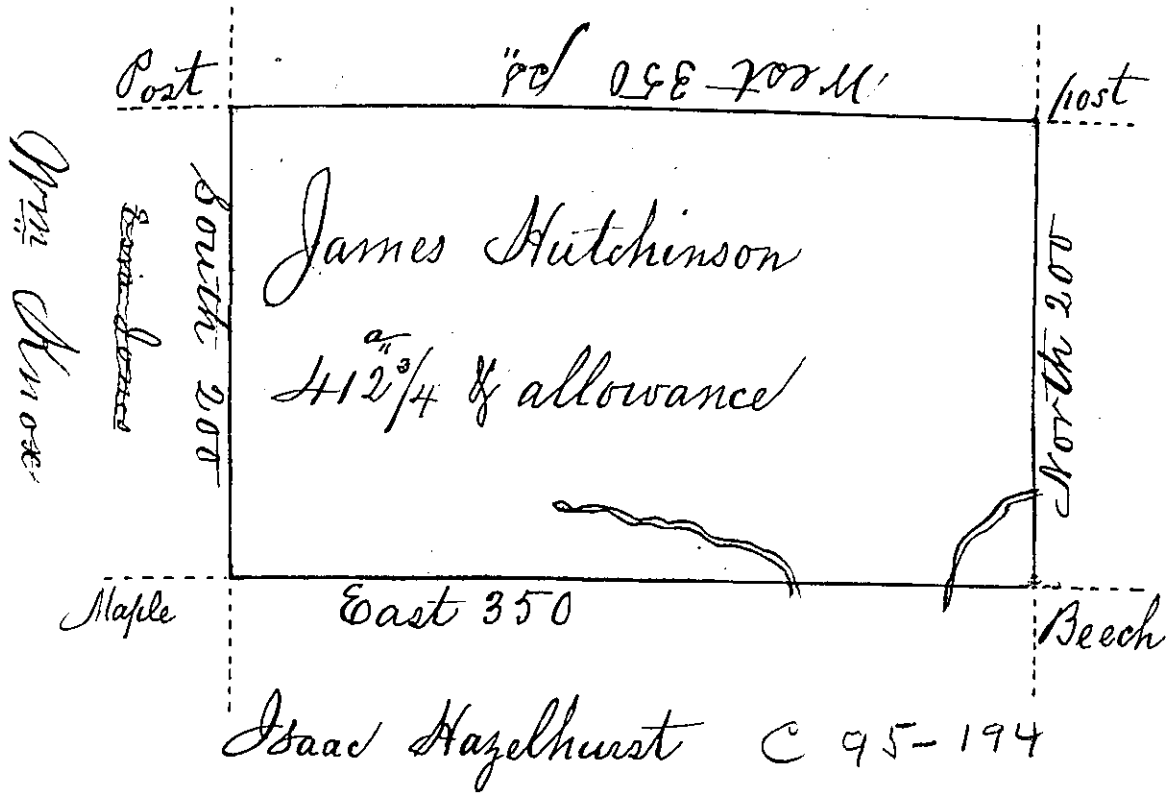


Robt. Heysham <sup>1550</sup>
