

Surveyed in June 1793 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793.

Note a Survey was made on the above warrant at the time aforesaid, including the above tract, and a return made into the Surveyor Generals office, which return can't be found in the office and is the reason why a new return is now made.
