The above is the draught of a Survey made April 5th 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Benjamin Jones on the 14th day of April 1792. Situate Northwest of the Ohio River, on the waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to John Nixon Esq, called Ceva — containing 425 acres & 16 Perches, with the usual allowance of 6 per cent, &c.
