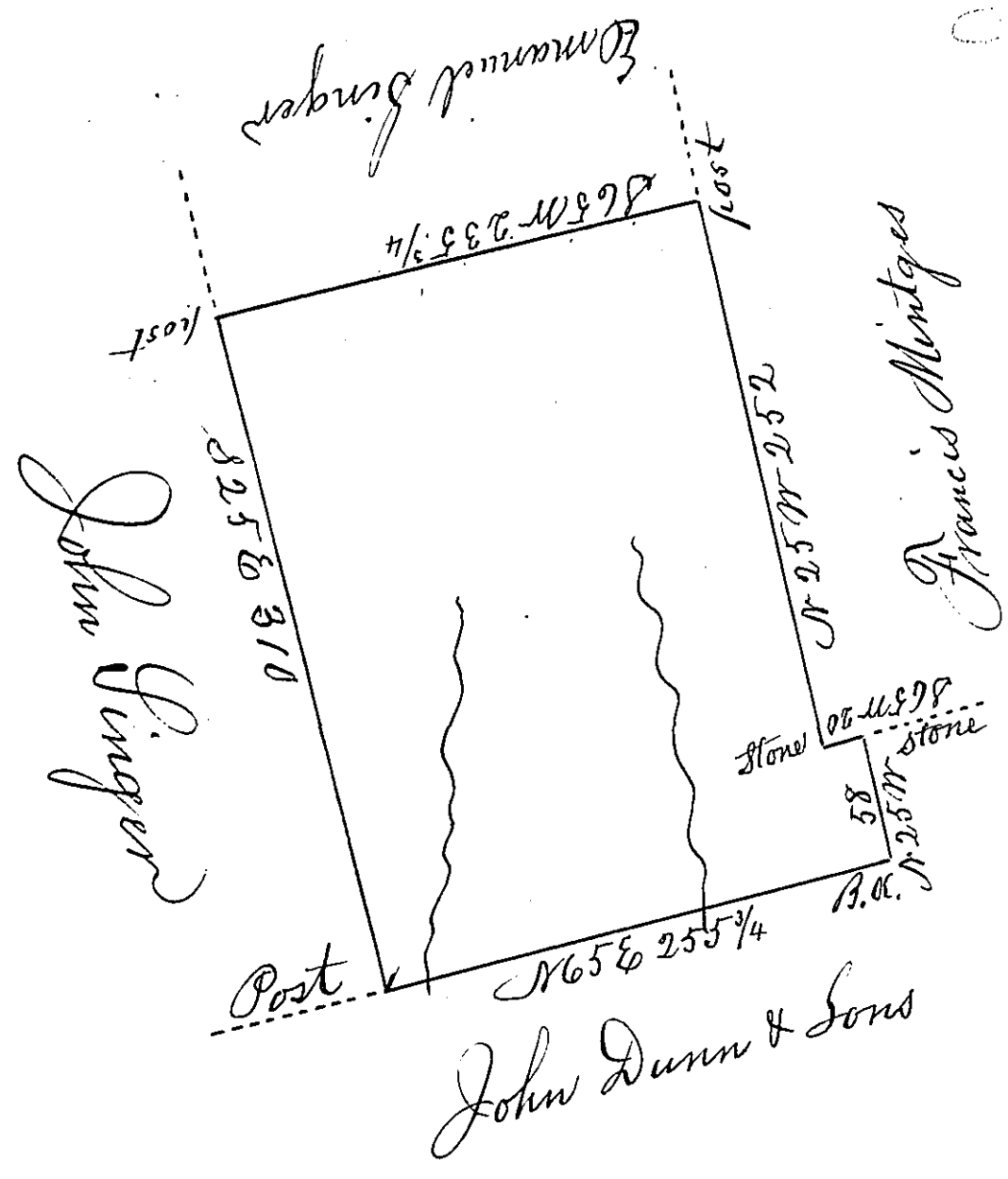


Do. Penn. Forest

By virtue of a warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1793,  
 Surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> August 1796 to Abraham Singers the  
 above described tract of land situate on the waters of  
 Heads Creek in Towamensing Township in the  
 County of Northampton, Containing four  
 hundred and thirty seven acres one hundred  
 and nineteen perches and the allowance  
 of six P. Cent. &c.
