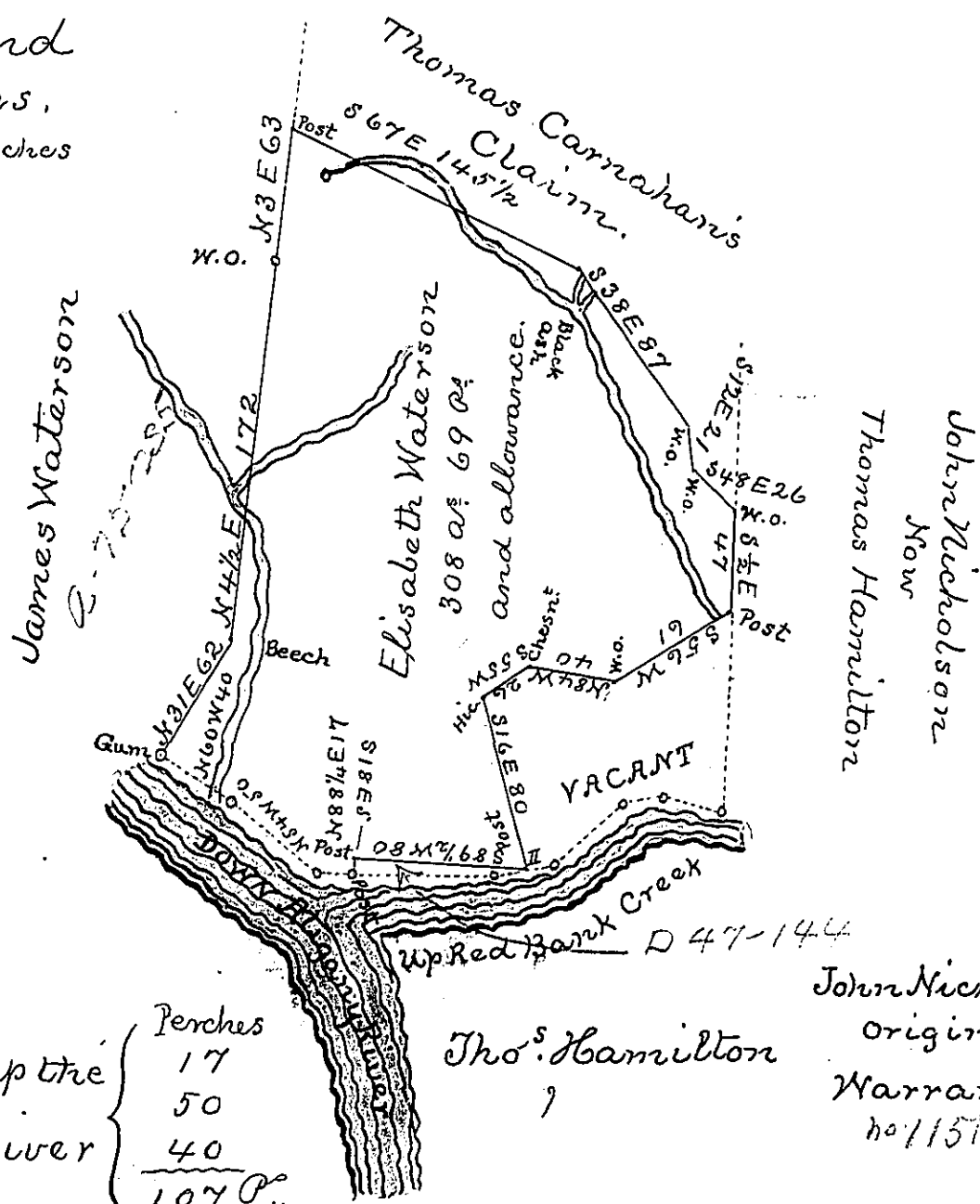

In pursuance of an Order dated Feb. 12th A.D. 1824 Resurveyed the above described tract of land on the fourth day of June 1827 containing three hundred and eight acres, sixty nine Perches and the allowance of six P. & C. &c Situate in Toby Township Armstrong County adjoining lands of Thomas Hamilton James Waterson and Thomas Carnahan and the Allegany River, being the same land was Surveyed to Elisabeth Waterson; on the 20th of April 1805 by Gen Ross Esquire then Deputy Surveyor P. Warrant of 20th July 1803 N^o 5842
