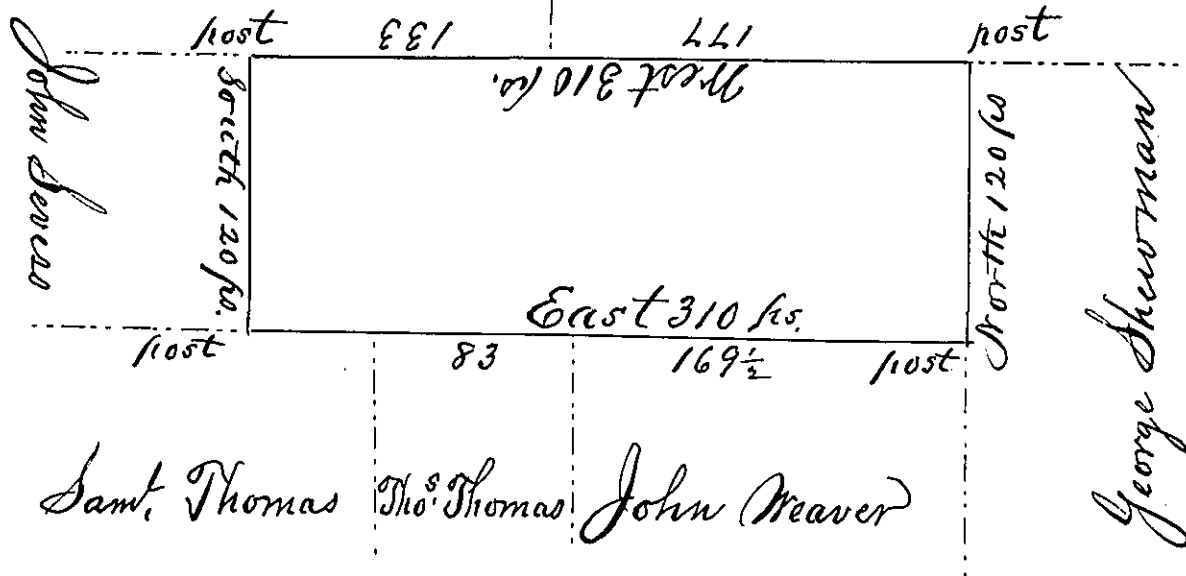


Thomas Ashton Thomas Adams
