



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Chest Corner situate on the heads of Water running into the Chest and beleafield creeks about two miles South from Alexander Stuarts Survey and adjoining Lands of Samuel Fisher, the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries and William Holey in the County of Bedford, containing three hundred and twenty eight Acres & three Quarters of an Acre and the usual Allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1773. for Thomas Smith in pursuance of an Order N<sup>o</sup>. 1831. Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1769.
