



Situate about one mile south of Cornelius Woodroughs in Bullskin Township Fayette County & surveyed the 28th day of October 1788. In consequence of a warrant granted to said Daniel Young for land on the Whitehorn run adjoining land of Robert Gordon on the North & William Findley on the East in the County of Westmoreland dated 1st day of September 1786, which land is certified by John Moore Esquire Deputy Surveyor, to be appointed, by warrant granted to Barbara Cauffman dated Feby, 8th 1786. and Daniel Young being an inhabitant of the County of Fayette, I have indulged him in laying it on the place above described in order to satisfy him for the money so expended, being ^{fully} satisfied that the State will not thereby be injured.
