Allotted and Surveyed for Captain John Brady being part of a larger Tract Surveyed in the monthe of March & April 1769. for the Officers of the first and second Battalion of the Pennsylvania Regmt. In pursuance of an Order N^o 1 dated the 3^d Feby 1769.
