



Situated on Bush Creek and the Waters thereof in Loudondeny Township on the East side of the Allegheny Mountains in Bedford County, containing One hundred and eighteen and one fourth Acres and the Allowance of Six Cent for Survey the 31<sup>st</sup> Day of December 1789 In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jacob Countryman dated the 29<sup>th</sup> January 1788.

The dotted lines represent a Survey made for Peter Kinige Junr. the 7<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1782. by Warrant Dated December 22<sup>d</sup> 1784. which intersects with Jacob Countryman's.
