



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the waters of Stump Creek or Punkstotaring, 274 perches East of the line of District No. 6, <sup>8</sup>/<sub>16</sub> about one mile from the 20<sup>th</sup> mile <sup>tree</sup> north of the West-branch of Susquehanna in the County of Northumberland containing 339 Acres and allowance of six acres per lot. Surveyed July the 29<sup>th</sup> 1785 for Dr. William Smith in pursuance of a warrant No. 524, bearing date at Philadelphia, May the 17<sup>th</sup> 1785.
