



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Upper Gofford Township now in the County of Montgomery (late Philadelphia) in the State of Pennsylvania, Containing Twenty-two Acres and Fifty perches of Land together with the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads, which by Virtue of a Warrant dated on the First day of July 1784, under the Hand of his Excellency the President of this State, was granted to Ulrich Heitzel, and Surveyed for him By order of the Surveyor General, on the 16th. October Anno 1784
