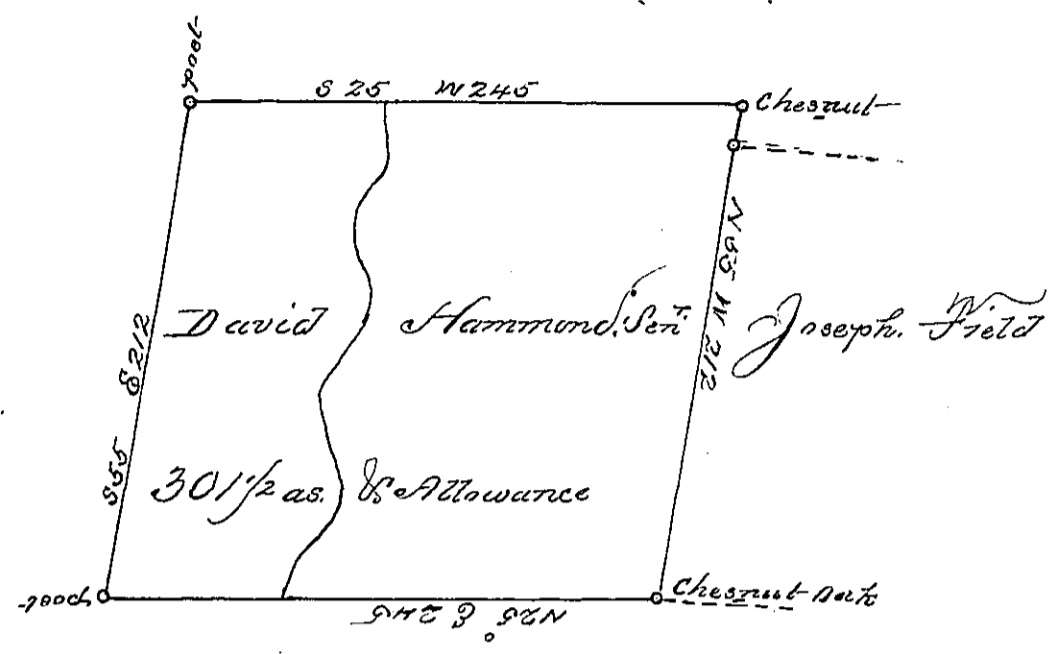


Vacant
