



A Draught of a survey lying on Peters C<sup>h</sup>. (Washington County), contg 333 Ac's & 80 P. without any allowance - executed May 13<sup>th</sup> 1785 for Benj<sup>n</sup> Custard in pursuance of a Certificate granted him for 400 Ac. by the Commis<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the Titles to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, York<sup>a</sup> & Ohio, and regularly entered with the County Surveyor as appears from the authenticated List of Entries - transmitted from the Office of the Surveyor Genl. -
