



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Stonehenge Situate on both sides of the Great road leading from Schuylkill to Fort Augusta about five or six miles beyond Francis Yarnells Settlement and on the waters of Shamokin Creek in the County of Northumberland, containing two hundred and sixty nine Acres and a quarter of an Acre besides the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads J<sup>ts</sup> Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1743 for William Tomlinson in Pursuance of a warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1743.
