In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783, for the Sale of certain lands therein mentioned, and by virtue of a Commission, under the Hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783. The above tract of land containing three hundred and fifty-one acres and one hundred and four perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. was surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 by
