



A Draught of a Tract of land surveyed the 5th. Day of June 1801. for Nathaniel Mc Giffen in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property of Penna. dated Lancaster January 22^d. 1801 directing that two returns should be transmitted into the Surveyor Generals Office of so much of each of the returns made for William Wilson, in 1784 upon two Applications Nos 3543 & 3544, in the names of Samuel & William Rippey, as hath not been effectually taken by other surveys. The above represents No. 3. & 6. in the General Draught of said Lands, and is a part of the Land surveyed the 19th day of April 1784 for William Wilson and clear of other surveys, Situate on the waters of the North branch of Ten Mile Creek in Washington County called Point Pretext, containing Two hundred acres together with the usual allowance of six y. Cont. for Roads
