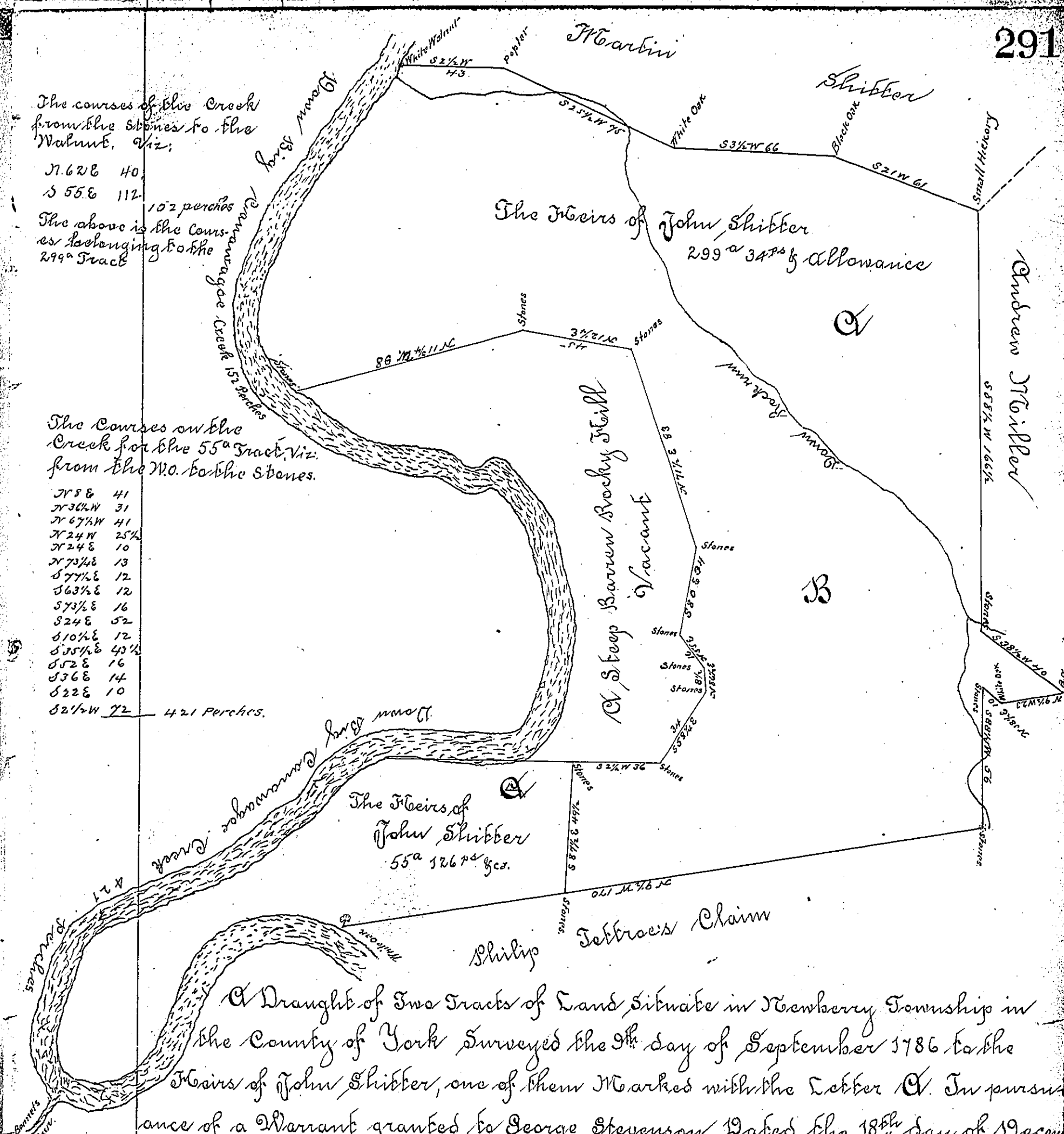

A Draught of Two Tracts of Land Situate in Newberry Township in the County of York Surveyed the 9th day of September 1786 to the Heirs of John Shitler, one of them Marked with the Letter A. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Stevenson Dated the 18th day of December 1751. Containing fifty five acres & one Hundred and Twenty Six perches & Allowance of six acres & Cent for Roads &c. The other Marked with the letter B In Pursuance of an Application granted to the said John Shitler Dated the 24th day of November 1768 and Numbered 5273 Containing Two Hundred & ninety nine acres and Thirty four perches and the usual allowance &c.
