



The Draught of a tract of land situate in Ferguson Township Centre County, containing three hundred and twenty four acres, fifty two perches and allowance of Six percent &c. Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1812 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Colemyer dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of December 1811.

At the time of making the above described Survey there was a Cabin house thereon, and Frederick Wise and family living in the same tenant to the said George Colemyer, about one acre of cleared land and some young apple & peach Trees planted on the same, it was first improved in May 1818.
