



By Virtue of a Warrant granted to James Wilson Edr. dated the second day of October A.D. 1793, numbered four thousand two hundred and sixty eight, was surveyed on the fourteenth day of April A.D. 1830 by Samuel Fulton Edr. the above described tract of Nine hundred Acres & 47 Perches & allowance of six per cent. of land.

Situate in Ridgeway Township, Jefferson County in the last purchase made of the Indians, East of the Allegheny River, and Conawaugo Creek.
