



Situate on the N.W. Side of Conemaugh River, in the Gap of the Laurel Hill in Conemaugh & Jackson Townships Cambria County containing one hundred and thirty two acres, forty three perches and allowance of six per cent, surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1830 for Archibald Mathews Esq.  
 In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Andrew Wilkins on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1830 for 200 A.S. The said Wilkins is living on the Land since 1<sup>st</sup> of March 1829.

Note The upper end of this Survey interferes with the courses and distances of the two Gills as above described, but no marks were found on the Ground.
