



By Virtue of an Order dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of the month called March 1743<sup>1/4</sup>. The above described Tract of Land was Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> month called May 1744 by my Father Samuel Lightfoot for William Branson Situated on a branch of the French Creek containing 172 Acres & the allowance of six p. Cent.
