



The above Draught Contains 25 Acres & 20 perches of Land and the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Situated in ~~the~~ Colerain township, Lancaster County, and is the East part of 231 acres granted to Daniel McCallan, by three separate Warrants, but returned under one Survey, the piece marked A. contains all that is held under the said Daniel McCallan's Warrant of 10 Acres, dated Octob. 31st 1740, and the other piece marked B. is a part of of the said Daniel McCallan's other Warrant of 150 Acres dated the 4th of Sept. 1745, And now Surveyed for Timothy Haines the 4th day of May 1835.
