



The above is the Draught of a Survey made August 14th 1828 for William Marks Esq^r in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Davidson dated 4th April 1797 for 150 acres of Land being improved situated in the Moon Township in Alleghany County now Moon Township in Beaver County containing one hundred sixty five acres three Rods four tenths and allow under of six per Cent for Roads & To Gabriel Heister Esq^r }
 Surveyor General Henry Davis S.J.

Note The land represented by the above Draught has been in a part thinly settled till of late years the Lands adjacent to it have been settled. I am informed by several of the old Settlers within a few miles of it that a certain William Richardson formerly owned Land in the neighborhood of the above Tract and which cannot correctly inform me and the Land Title thereabouts having been so often transferred and owners names changed I am not able at present to state particularly where said Richardson's Land joined the above. But I know that Arthur Gardner did own (or claim) Land adjoining the above and that he had disposed of it to Samuel Wilson above mentioned as an adjoiner
